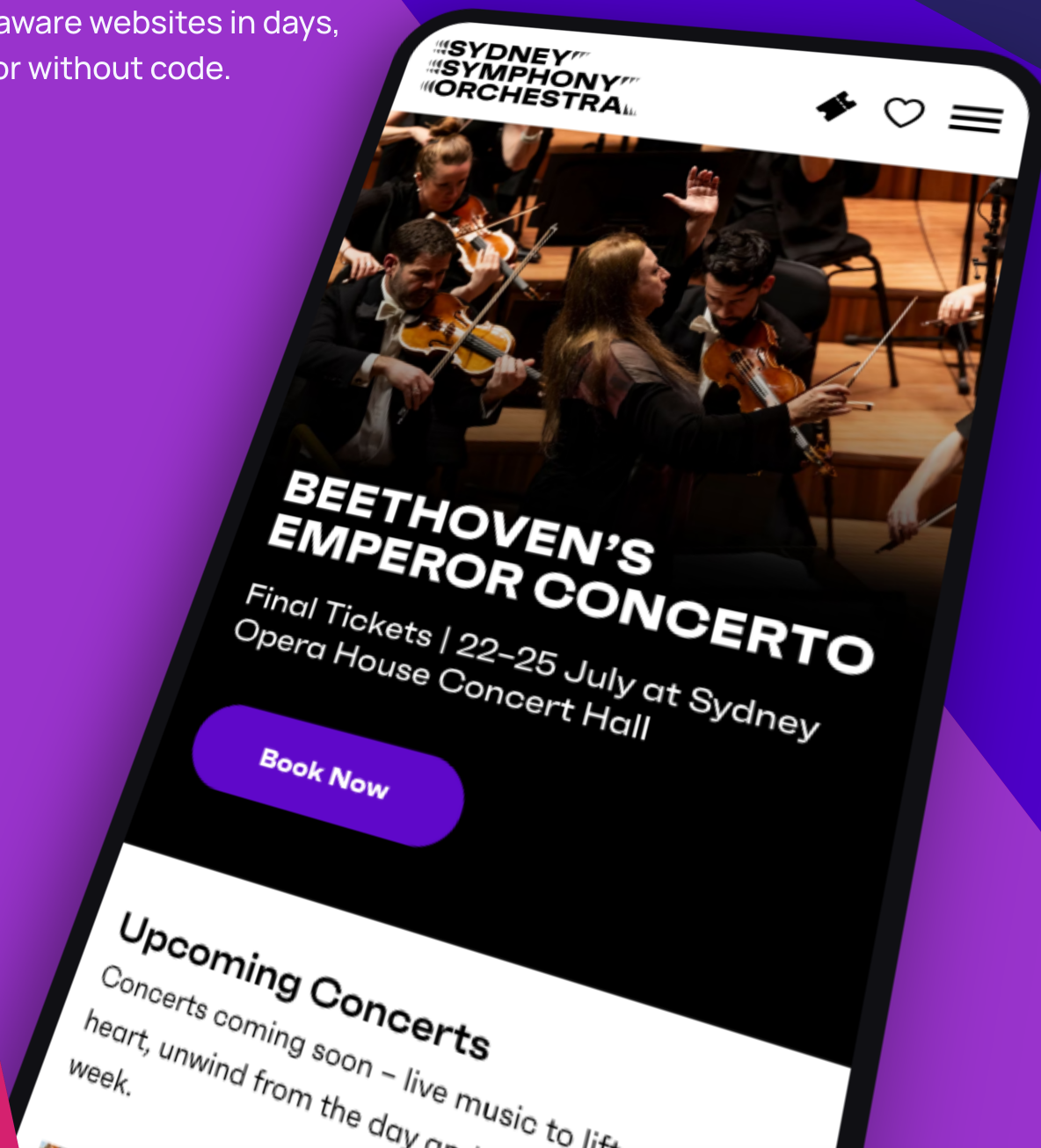

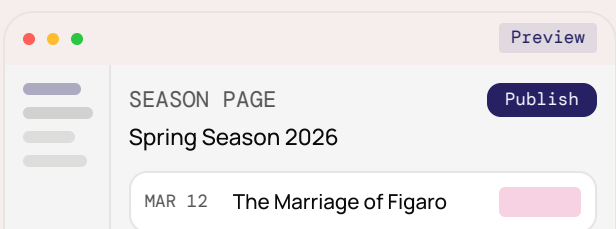

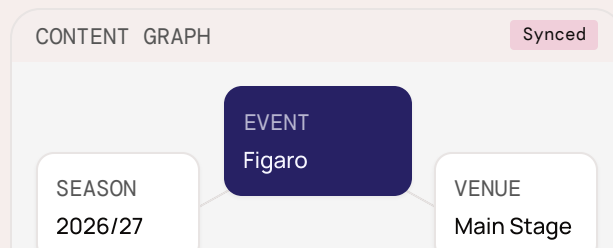
Publish a season without a deploy
